Twenty-Two New Year Tips for Better Living ~ In 2022

"Trust in the LORD and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this: He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun." (Psalm 37:3-6 NIV).

Twenty-Two tips for living a better Christian life in the New Year:

- 1. Rise early and pray every day: "Asking God to use YOU every day; Commit and trust YOUR life and way to God. Ask God to use YOU to be "Jesus" to those YOU meet; Ask God to let YOU touch their lives and meet them just where they are!
 - 2. Don't sweat the small stuff; for its all-small stuff in the realm of God's divine plan.

- 13. There is no pillow as soft as a "positive attitude and a clear conscience."
- 14. Stay positive and committed— "Don't quit... Don't every give up!"
- 15. When God is silent. "Believe in the SON even when the SUN isn't shining." Believe YOU are LOVABLE even when YOU are alone. Believe in God even when He is silent.
- 16. Cry when needed. "Every unshed tear is a prism through which all of life's hurts are distorted." God cares and knows YOUR every need. Just know "God's Got This."
- 17. Laugh a lot—laughter is motivating and good for YOU; It's still the best medicine.
- 18. Remember, "The bumps of life are what we climb on." The bumps are the stepping- stones to overcoming YOUR deepest challenges in life. "Don't Quit! Don't ever give up!"
- 19. "Do not be afraid...Fear not." At least 95 percent of the things we are anxious about or fear, never happen. Trust God for the other five percent. "God's Got This!"
- 20. Take a daily "Thank-You God Walk." You can't be stressed and thankful at the same time. Feel blessed and you won't be stressed.
- 21. Celebrate YOUR faith and put God first with YOUR time, talents, & tithe (money). God will do the rest... Just step out in faith... and trust God for the best results!
- 22. Each day of the New Year 2022 count your many "Blessings... and Be Thankful."

Ways to Give to New Hope

Thanks to the Moravian Ministries Foundation of America (MMFA), we now have an online option to donate to New Hope via credit card or direct debit (automatic bank to bank transfer). The MMFA provides the

This is a great option for Friends of New Hope that no longer live in the area. These donations will be tracked for tax filing purposes. Transaction fees do apply, just under 3% for credit card transactions and \$0.75 for direct debit transactions.

The MMFA also provides a means to donate securities/stocks. Your broker transfers the securities/stocks to MMFA and the MMFA executes the securities/stocks into cash. Securities/stocks executed in this way are not subject to capital gains tax. Please contact Tom Schultz if you are interested in the process for this type of monetary transaction.
