"Seeking... A Life of Spiritual Success God's Way"

"Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the instructions Moses gave you. Do not deviate from them, turning either to the right or to the left. Then you will be successful in everything you do" Joshua 1:7NLT.

Many years ago, God gave His people, the ancient Israelites, a specific goal, and formula for both personal and spiritual success. The goal was to claim and possess the Promised Land which, in time, became the country we know today as Israel. Yes, the Israelites did wander around for forty-years. Yet, God remained faithful; He protected them, and He provided for them.

If we want to be successful—as Christians, in the eyes of God, we need to challenge ourselves and not play it safe but TRUST Him to make a way for us. We need to discover our God-given purpose and goal in life. We need to be sold-out and committed to our God-given purpose. Far too many people in our world today, drift through life allowing "life as it happens" to determine their future, rather than specifically seeking God's clearly defined direction for their abundant Christian life. As Christians, it is imperative we avoid sinful words and actions; we must avoid going our own way. God's Word defines clearly "the way, and the truth and the life" John 14:6 NIV. We just

need to be obedient and follow the example set-forth by Jesus Christ. Then our life will be more clearly defined not by our control but through "God's Eternal Plan" for our life.

Psychologists have been telling us for years, if we want to be successful, we need to set well defined goals. Victor Frankl, the Viennese psychiatrist, says "not having a goal is more to be feared than not reaching a goal."

What is your purpose and goal today? If you want to be truly successful both personally and spiritually, seek God's plan for your life; seek Jesus Christ in all your ways. As Henry Blackaby states in his book, Experiencing God, "Find where God is already working in your life and then join Him there." Let go and let God lead you to His clearly defined life of purpose. Let God help you set your goals! Be open to His leading, and His placement of circumstances, people and places, to help you reach your goals.

The first step in discovering your life's purpose and goal starts with prayer (spending daily time with God). Then put your prayerful thoughts and goals on paper; be specific. Always remember: Godly success is the ability to formulate a worthwhile purpose and goal. Then (do not) try to go it alone; employ all of God's powers for the achievement of that goal.

Jack Canfield, author of the Chicken Soup for the Soul series states, "If you are clear where you are going and you take steps in that direction every day, you eventually have to get there." If I head south toward Florida and take five steps a day, eventually I have to end up in Florida. So today, prayerfully decide God's purpose for your life, write it down, and each day, do something that moves you closer toward this purpose and goal.

This co-ed program provides the resources and support the youth need to complete education, find and keep a job, establish a support network outside the program, manage their finances, and learn the many soft skills necessary to live successfully on their own. This gives people who choose to stay in their car an option to listen to the service on their car radio. This also gives us the ability to conduct a service if the weather is bad. Pastor Betty and the music can be under a shelter or inside the church building and broadcast to people parked in the lot.

Congregation participation is a vital part of worship. The Board of Elders approved singing and responding to responsive reading. With this in mind, please follow our safety precautions of masking and safe distance (at least 6 feet). The use of our FM transmitter has been a great addition for those worshipping in their cars. Steve Larson will continue to read the congregation response in the liturgy, and we may participate following the above mentioned guidelines.

Restrooms in the church are open before, during and following Sunday worship. The Board of Elders do ask that you enter through the main front doors to use the restrooms. We also ask that only one family at a time use the restrooms. Please sanitize your hands as you enter and exit the restrooms, masked and practice social distancing.
