The Lord Is Risen! The Lord [Christ] Is Risen INDEED!!!

Well, it's April... And we're preparing for Palm Sunday and Easter Sunrise and our Easter Morning Worship Service. This month, I'd like to discuss these special services and their intense centrality to the life of Christ Church and His followers. Why?

Scripture states, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." 1 Peter 1:3

What is the main message of Palm Sunday and Easter? LOVE!!! God's LOVE!!! A LOVE so great that Creator-God, the Father of "Heaven and Earth" poured His divine power into flesh. He lived, He bled, He died, and He was Resurrected: All to reconcile us to Himself. He did all this for us (His children), even with all our human imperfections.

In God's great LOVE, He gave us the freedom to choose Him... God's LOVE is revealed in an epic true love story that we pull up close as we acknowledge the miracle of Jesus Resurrection. All throughout Scripture we see God's abounding LOVE for His people and the depth of Jesus LOVE for us as God's children: The Church (followers of Christ Jesus) are the Body of Christ.

Even in our imperfect and perishable state, God still loves us and receives us just as we are. In a body that will perish, we still have a divine spirit, connected to our Creator. A God who so loved us, He gave His Beloved Son to conquer death and give us eternal life (John 3:16).

Christ Jesus' journey to the Cross and His life-changing Resurrection should be transforming every aspect of our lives. Who we are, and what we do? If not, then, we are only experiencing religious emotions. Without, our total commitment to Christ the Risen Savior's leading, we will be living our lives more like the secular world, than being Christ-like chosen ones.

Church, we are the body of Christ; We are to live holy and righteous lives before others in the world. For us to live our lives touched by the words "Christ Is Risen! Christ Is Risen Indeed". We must completely TRUST God. We are to start living our (eternal life) on this earth now! We are to be living under God's Precepts. We are not to be anxious of the trials and troubles of this life, nor be afraid of our imminent death. Many in our world today, will do ANYTHING to avoid trials, pain, aging, illness, and death. People go to amazing lengths to deny the prospect of life's trials and their untimely death. Psalm 55:22 reminds us, "Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken." These words are comforting to me. For us as Christians, Christ Resurrection means, we are to live free from sin's power and control over our lives. I don't know about you, but I like hearing God is the Master of my life, that He loves us that much! Yes, I am His and you are His...Remember what Psalm 55:22 said, "He will never let the righteous be shaken." These words are music to my ears because I need my Savior to abide with me. I need Christ to sustain me every day from all the cares of this life and afterward. I need Him to prepare me for the curve balls of life that are sure to come, as I serve Him and others. We all need a "Risen Savior" that loves, protects, and guides us.

Brothers and Sisters, Easter isn't just about coloring-eggs, eating marshmallow bunnies, jellybeans, delicious chocolate Easter bunnies, or buying our new Easter outfits. No indeed... Palm Sunday (Jesus' journey to the Cross) and Easter are about new life: (the eternal life) we gain from our "Risen Lord and Savior!"

Always Remember: Christ Jesus, "Birth, Life, Death and Resurrection" were conceived, foretold, and realized by God's abounding great LOVE for us. In Christ Jesus, we are "set free" to LOVE, FORGIVE and SERVE. In Christ Jesus, we find PEACE, JOY, HOPE, and LOVE. Palm Sunday and Easter are about our embracing Christ Jesus of the Cross with all our being. It's about our sharing in Christ Jesus VICTORY over sin and death. Palm Sunday and Easter are about our embracing our journey of an "abundant life" with Christ Jesus on this earth and for all eternity!
