"What is faith? It is the confident assurance that something we want is going to happen. It is the certainty that what we hope for is waiting for us, even though we cannot see it up ahead. Men of God in days of old were famous for their faith "Hebrews 11:1-2 (TLB) (NLT).

It's been said that if you want to hit home runs you've got to be willing to strike out. Top batters in baseball have all struck out many times, but it doesn't keep them from trying. And most people who have succeeded in life have also struck out many times. Perhaps today you are feeling like you have struck out, but you just cannot throw in the towel. Well, for sure, you are not alone.

For example, did you know that Walt Disney went broke seven times and had a nervous breakdown before he became successful? At age 40 Henry Ford was broke. Thomas Edison failed more than 6,000 times before he could get an electric light bulb to work; as a child, one of his teachers even called him a dunce. Abraham Lincoln was well known for his many failures but became one of America's most beloved presidents. And Albert Einstein and Werner von Braun both flunked courses in mathematics. History is filled with similar stories.

The reason these people all succeeded is because they didn't quit; they refused to give up. They believed they could succeed and they stuck with it until they did. As the old saying goes, "Quitters never win and winners never quit!" So, if you and I want to hit some home runs spiritually, we must get out there and flex our spiritual muscles. We need to plant our feet beside our firm foundation (Jesus), and keep on swinging and trying. This is true in all aspects of our lives. When the going gets rough and things begin to get tough; we must refuse to cave in. For we have the greatest encourager, anyone can have. We have our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ cheering us on. Isaiah 54:17 states, "No weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. Yadkin View RCC Women's Event/Workshop


Location: New Hope Moravian Church Newton, NC


"Wheee Doggies!"
