"The righteous are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season.

Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do."

(Psalm 1:3)



"The Lord gave me this message: "I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born, I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations."

Jeremiah 1:4-5 NLT

In the first chapter of Jeremiah, The Lord gave Jeremiah a specific calling on his life. I don't know about you, but I could read these verses over and over. Many think this passage applied only to Jeremiah, but I tend to believe that the Bible is God's holy Word. Therefore, God is speaking to all of us. Clearly, this passage applies to you and me, just as it did to Jeremiah. God may not call us to be a prophet, but God formed us and has chosen us for an important task or mission that "matters" in His Kingdom.

In our Scripture today, God is giving us three principles for us to heed:

First, I knew you... God knew everything about us even before we were born. Imagine that... Clearly, God knows us better than we know ourselves! Psalm 139:16 tells us: "Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be."

Second, I set you apart... God has chosen us for a divine purpose. A purpose that "matters" ... We are unique and special to God. What we do with our lives matters to God. God created each one of us for a divine & unique purpose. Deuteronomy 14:2 says, "You have been set apart as holy to the LORD your God, and he has chosen you from all the nations of the earth to be his own special treasure."

Third, I appointed you... God has called each one of us with an appointed purpose. He sends us out into the "highways and byways" as His children. As His children, we are pilgrims in this world and are only passing through this earthly life for a short time. We are to give testimony to the world for what He "has done and is doing" in our lives. John 15:16 says, "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you."

As God's children and pilgrims in this world, we may at times lose sight of our divine purpose, and we may feel discouraged. Yet, remember God is with us and He has fully equipped us to do whatever divine purpose He calls us to do. Remember, God has made us uniquely who we are, and we are His children. God does not make JUNK! He knew us and created us, He set us apart, and He appointed us to do whatever He has called each of us to do. Because in our own human strength, "we can do NO-thing."

However, in Christ Jesus, Philippians 4:13 NKJV says, "I [we] can do all things through Christ who strengthens me [us]." "For nothing will be impossible with God" Luke 1:37 ESV.

Therefore, just as God prepared Jeremiah for the task set before him (in the time period) he lived; God also prepares us for the times we are living. I like the thought that, **He knew us** and was **preparing us** since **before we were born**, we can be confident that He is with us. God will direct us on our journey and make straight our pathway (to do) ALL He has **set us apart for and appointed us to do**.

God made each of us uniquely who we are... Scripture states: "So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God, he created them; male and female he created them "Genesis 1:27 NLT.

God in His sovereignty never made another person like you, and He never will. There is no one that possesses the same gifts as you and no one can do the things you do like you do. All the strength we need to do what God calls us to do comes from Him. God is our strength, and we can trust that "we can do all things through Him."

Even in moments of difficult trials and discouragement, let us ALWAYS remember that God has chosen us to do great things. Our LIFE and what we do MATTERS to God! He knows everything about us, and still chose us to be His children. When we make the decision to see ourselves as God sees us, we will begin reaching our FULL potential and be used by God in a MIGHTY way. Just as God told Jeremiah, he is also telling us "Get up and prepare for action!" Jeremiah 1:17 (NLT).

Dear Ones, thank you for hearing and answering God's call on your life! Always remember, what you do in life MATTERS to God and to others. Your life "matters."
